2023-2024 Eligibility Guidelines

Our Head Start program is for preschool and Transitional Kindergarten age eligible children. Your child must be 3 or 4 years of age by the school cutoff date of September 1 OR be 3 years of age at the time of enrollment.

We also provide California State Preschool Program (CSPP) services, which are combined with our Head Start Preschool program. We qualify family income by Head Start income guidelines FIRST.

Our Early Head Start program serves pregnant women and children ages 0 to 2 years old by the school cutoff date of September 1.
